BE SPECIFIC WITH YOUR TIME: HOURS, WEEKS, YEARS

NON-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES: Volunteering, religious or cultural involvement, instrument lessons, etc.

Student Researcher, 20 hours per week, 4 weeks per year. Grades 11, 12.

Volunteer at an aquarium focused on local marine life. Assisted biologists in their daily routine of testing water quality,

observing aquatic-life behavior, and record keeping. Invited back for a second year to do a paid internship,

made responsible for training and supervising new volunteers.
